WE MUST APPROACH THIS STUDY WITH HUMILITY, RECOGNIZING THE LIMITATIONS OF HUMAN LANGUAGE TO FULLY CAPTURE THE INFINITE GOD.

CHAPTER 1: THE TRANSCENDENT GOD: BEYOND HUMAN COMPREHENSION

THIS CHAPTER DELVES INTO THE ATTRIBUTES THAT HIGHLIGHT GOD'S TRANSCENDENCE—HIS EXISTENCE BEYOND AND ABOVE THE CREATED ORDER.

H1: INFINITY: GOD IS WITHOUT LIMITS OR BOUNDARIES. HIS EXISTENCE EXTENDS BEYOND ANY SPATIAL OR TEMPORAL LIMITATIONS. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE:

PSALM 147:5; ISAIAH 45:5; 1 TIMOTHY 1:17)

H2: ETERNITY: GOD EXISTS OUTSIDE OF TIME. HE IS NOT SUBJECT TO TEMPORAL LIMITATIONS; HE HAS ALWAYS EXISTED AND WILL ALWAYS EXIST. HIS ETERNITY IS NOT SIMPLY ENDLESS DURATION BUT A TIMELESS EXISTENCE, TRANSCENDING THE LINEAR PROGRESSION OF TIME AS WE EXPERIENCE IT. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PSALM 90:2; REVELATION 1:8)

H3: IMMUTABILITY: GOD IS UNCHANGING IN HIS BEING, CHARACTER, AND PURPOSES. THIS DOES NOT MEAN HE IS STATIC OR UNFEELING BUT THAT HIS ESSENTIAL NATURE IS ETERNALLY PERFECT AND CONSTANT. HE DOES NOT CHANGE HIS MIND OR HIS PROMISES. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: MALACHI 3:6; JAMES 1:17; HEBREWS 6:18)

H4: SELF-EXISTENCE: GOD IS THE UNCAUSED CAUSE, THE SOURCE OF ALL EXISTENCE. HE DOESN'T DEPEND ON ANYTHING OR ANYONE ELSE FOR HIS BEING. HE IS THE ULTIMATE GROUND OF REALITY, THE "I AM" WHO EXISTS ETERNALLY AND INDEPENDENTLY. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: EXODUS 3:14; ISAIAH 44:6)

CHAPTER 2: THE IMMANENT GOD: PRESENT AND ACTIVE IN CREATION

THIS CHAPTER FOCUSES ON ATTRIBUTES THAT DEMONSTRATE GOD'S IMMANENCE – HIS ACTIVE PRESENCE AND INVOLVEMENT IN HIS CREATION.

H1: OMNIPRESENCE: GOD IS PRESENT EVERYWHERE AT ONCE. HE IS NOT CONFINED TO ANY PARTICULAR LOCATION BUT PERMEATES ALL OF CREATION. HIS PRESENCE IS NOT MERELY SPATIAL BUT ALSO RELATIONAL; HE IS INTIMATELY INVOLVED IN EVERY ASPECT OF HIS CREATION. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PSALM 139:7-10; JEREMIAH 23:24)

H2: OMNISCIENCE: GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING—PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE. HIS KNOWLEDGE IS NOT MERELY INTELLECTUAL BUT ENCOMPASSES ALL THINGS, INCLUDING THE THOUGHTS AND INTENTIONS OF EVERY PERSON. HIS OMNISCIENCE IS NOT INTRUSIVE BUT PART OF HIS PERFECT UNDERSTANDING OF HIS CREATION. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PSALM 139:1-6; HEBREWS 4:13)

H3: OMNIPOTENCE: GOD IS ALL-POWERFUL. HIS POWER IS UNLIMITED AND ABSOLUTE; HE IS CAPABLE OF DOING ANYTHING CONSISTENT WITH HIS NATURE AND WILL. THIS POWER IS NOT ARBITRARY BUT IS EXERCISED ACCORDING TO HIS PERFECT WISDOM AND LOVE. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: GENESIS 18:14; ISAIAH 40:28; REVELATION 19:6)

CHAPTER 3: THE MORAL ATTRIBUTES OF GOD: HOLINESS, JUSTICE, AND LOVE

THIS SECTION EXAMINES THE ATTRIBUTES THAT REVEAL GOD'S MORAL CHARACTER.

H1: HOLINESS: GOD IS PERFECTLY PURE, SEPARATE FROM SIN, AND UTTERLY RIGHTEOUS. HIS HOLINESS IS NOT MERELY THE ABSENCE OF EVIL BUT A POSITIVE, RADIANT PERFECTION THAT DEMANDS REVERENCE AND WORSHIP. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: ISAIAH 6:3; 1 PETER 1:16; REVELATION 4:8)

H2: JUSTICE: GOD IS PERFECTLY JUST; HE ALWAYS ACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH HIS RIGHTEOUS STANDARDS. HIS JUSTICE IS NOT ARBITRARY PUNISHMENT BUT THE UPHOLDING OF TRUTH AND RIGHTEOUSNESS IN THE UNIVERSE. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: DEUTERONOMY 32:4; PSALM 89:14; ROMANS 2:2)

H3: LOVE: GOD'S LOVE IS THE FOUNDATION OF HIS CHARACTER AND ACTIONS. IT IS NOT MERELY SENTIMENTALITY BUT A SELF-GIVING, SACRIFICIAL LOVE THAT SEEKS THE GOOD OF OTHERS. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: JOHN 3:16; 1 JOHN 4:8, 16)

H4: MERCY AND GRACE: GOD'S MERCY IS HIS COMPASSION AND FORGIVENESS TOWARD THOSE WHO HAVE SINNED AGAINST HIM. HIS GRACE IS HIS UNMERITED FAVOR AND BLESSING BESTOWED UPON UNDESERVING RECIPIENTS. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PSALM 103:8-14; EPHESIANS 2:8-9)

CHAPTER 4: GOD'S RELATIONAL ATTRIBUTES: FAITHFULNESS, WISDOM, AND SOVEREIGNTY

THIS CHAPTER EXPLORES ATTRIBUTES THAT HIGHLIGHT GOD'S RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS CREATION.

H1: FAITHFULNESS: GOD IS COMPLETELY TRUSTWORTHY; HE ALWAYS KEEPS HIS PROMISES AND FULFILLS HIS PURPOSES. HIS

FAITHFULNESS IS A SOURCE OF COMFORT AND HOPE FOR BELIEVERS. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: DEUTERONOMY 7:9; LAMENTATIONS 3:22-23; 1 CORINTHIANS 1:9)

H2: WISDOM: GOD POSSESSES PERFECT WISDOM; HE KNOWS THE BEST COURSE OF ACTION IN EVERY SITUATION. HIS WISDOM GUIDES HIS ACTIONS AND PROVIDES DIRECTION FOR HIS PEOPLE. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PROVERBS 3:19-20; ROMANS 11:33; JAMES 1:5)

H3: SOVEREIGNTY: GOD IS THE ULTIMATE AUTHORITY AND RULER OF THE UNIVERSE. HIS SOVEREIGNTY DOES NOT NEGATE HUMAN RESPONSIBILITY BUT EMPHASIZES HIS ULTIMATE CONTROL AND PURPOSE IN ALL THINGS. (RELEVANT SCRIPTURE: PSALM 115:3; DANIEL 4:35; EPHESIANS 1:11)

CHAPTER 5: THE FATHERHOOD OF GOD: A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP

THIS CHAPTER EXPLORES THE IMPLICATIONS OF GOD'S FATHERHOOD.

GOD'S FATHERHOOD IS NOT MERELY A METAPHOR BUT A PROFOUND REALITY THAT SHAPES OUR UNDERSTANDING OF OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM. IT SIGNIFIES HIS LOVE, PROTECTION, PROVISION, DISCIPLINE, AND GUIDANCE. 1. WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF GOD'S HOLINESS? HIS HOLINESS DEMANDS REVERENCE, WORSHIP, AND A LIFE OF OBEDIENCE.
1. HOW DOES GOD'S LOVE DIFFER FROM HUMAN LOVE? GOD'S LOVE IS PERFECT, SELFLESS, AND UNCHANGING, EXCEEDING HUMAN CAPACITY.
1. WHAT IS THE PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY? IT ENCOURAGES TRUST, SUBMISSION, AND PERSEVERANCE IN GOD'S PLAN.
